ITINERARY

DAY-1 - DEPARTURE MANILA ARRIVAL ZURICH (D) Meet at NAIA Terminal 1 Check-in airline Flight going to ZURICH. Enjoy Inflight Amenities Arrival Zurich International. Meet and assist with our guide.

Transfer to our hotel for check in and resting. We will visit Zurich Old Town.

Dinner and overnight will be in the hotel.

DAY-2 - ZURICH - TITLIS - LUCERNE - ZURICH (B,D) Breakfast at the hotel. Travel to Engelberg to visit and enjoy the breathtaking panoramas of snow-capped mountain tops and untouched Alpine landscapes Mount Titlis in Switzerland, cableways will transport you in safety and comfort to an altitude of up to 3,020 metres (10,623ft) high above sea level. Ride the world's first rotating cable car and be amazed with the spectacular view up the summit of Mt. Titlis. Enjoy the illuminated Glacier Cave, experience the Titlis Cliff Walk - the highest elevation suspension bridge in Europe. Afterwards continue to Lucerne where you see the Swiss city's famous landmarks including Chapel Bridge, Water Tower and some immaculately preserved Baroque and Gothic buildings. Free time. Proceed to Zurich. Upon arrival, panoramic city tour in Zurich. This tour shows you the highlights of Zurich and its surroundings. Start with a guided city tour of Zurich and see the commercial centre, a section of the Old Town, Fraumuenster Church with its famous Chagall windows, historical Limmatquai and the university district. Along the Hohenstrasse that offers spectacular views into the Alps, we drive to Rapperswil, known as 'City of Roses'. This charming little town offers unique attractions, including the Rose Gardens, the Castle, the deer park on the Lindenholz and the picturesque Old Town. Free time. Dinner will be in local restaurant. Overnight will be in the hotel.

DAY-3 - ZURICH - LUGANO - COMO - MILAN (B,D) After breakfast, check out from the hotel. Proceed to Lugano. Upon arrival, visit Lugano Lake and take some free time with the view of Lugano Lake. Afterwards, departure for Como. Upon arrival, we will have panoramic city tour in Como. We will start with old town, the old town, which is shaped like a quadrangle, is surrounded by fortress walls dating back to the twelfth century. Take a walk through the streets of Via Odescalchi, Adamo del Pera, and Vittori and explore many fascinating buildings that date back to the pre-medieval period. Stroll through the old town of Como and feel the charming atmosphere and charm of the city. We will have 1 hour boat tour on the Lake Como. The lake is shaped like an up-side-down Y, with three slender branches that meet at the resort town of Bellagio. Proceed to Milan. We will discover Milan, a metropolis in Italy's northern Lombardy region, is a global capital of fashion and design. Home to the national stock exchange, it's a financial hub also known for its high-end dining and shopping. The guide will show you "The Gothic Duomo di Milano Cathedral" and the Santa Maria delle Grazie convent "The Last Supper", testify to centuries of art and culture. Explore more of Milano and free time will be given. Afterwards, free time. Dinner will be in local restaurant. Transfer to hotel and overnight will be in the hotel.

DAY-4 - MILAN - VENICE (B,D) After breakfast, check out from the hotel. Departure for Venice. Proceed to Venice. Upon arrival, we'll take you through this fascinating city of ornate palaces, lyrical waterways, captivating churches and impressive architecture. In San Marco Square you'll see the Basilica di San Marco, one of the best examples of Byzantine architecture, and the Bridge of Sighs connecting the old prison to the interrogation rooms in Doge's Palace. Afterwards, you'll get a chance to see some traditional Venetian craftsmanship at a demonstration by Murano glassblowers. Free time. Transfer to hotel for check in and resting. Overnight will be in the hotel.

DAY-5 - VENICE - VILLACH - SALZBURG (B,D) Breakfast in the hotel and check out. Departure for Salzburg. On the way, visit Villach which is a city on the Drava River in the Austrian province of Carinthia, near the Italian and Slovenian borders. It's known as a gateway to nearby lakes Faak and Ossiach, as well as the Villach Alps. On the main square, St. Jakob's Church steeple has sweeping views. Nearby in Schillerpark, the Relief von Kärtner is a giant 3D scale model of Carinthia. Afterwards, proceed to Salzburg. Upon arrival, panoramic city tour in Salzburg. During the city tour; See Mozart Birthplace, Salzburger Altstadt, Salzburg Fortress, Salzburg Cathedral, Mirabell Palace and gardens will be visited. Mozart's birthplace was the birthplace of Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart at No. 9 Getreidegasse in Salzburg, Austria. The Mirabell Palace was built by Prince Archbishop Wolf Dietrich in 1669 for his mistress, Salome Alt, and her children. Free time for shopping. Transfer to hotel for check in and resting. We will visit Salzburg Christmas Market. Dinner and accommodation will be in the hotel.

DAY-6 - SALZBURG - VIENNA (B,D) After breakfast, check out from the hotel. Departure for Vienna. "Vienna is a city which is surrounded by historical buildings and today Vienna is the most chosen city for visitors in the Europe". The Opera House, Ringstrasse, Hofburg Imperial Palace, City Hall, Parliament, St. Stephen's Cathedral, Stadtpark, Schönbrunn Palace will be seen during the city tour. Schönbrunn Palace was the main summer residence of the Habsburg rulers, located in Hietzing, Vienna. The 1,441-room Baroque palace is one of the most important architectural, cultural, and historic monuments in the country. Since the mid-1950s it has been a major tourist attraction. Afterwards, free time in center of Vienna. Dinner will be in local restaurant. Transfer to hotel for check in and resting. Overnight will be in the hotel.

DAY-7 - VIENNA - PARNDORF OUTLET - BRATISLAVA - BUDAPEST (B,D) Breakfast at the hotel and check out. Proceed to Parndorf Outlet for shopping. 10:00 AM - 14:00 PM, will be free time for shopping. Departure for Bratislava which is the capital of Slovakia, is set along the Danube River by the border with Austria and Hungary. It's surrounded by vineyards and the Little Carpathian Mountains, crisscrossed with forested hiking and cycling trails. The pedestrian-only, 18th-century old town is known for its lively bars and cafes. Perched atop a hill, the reconstructed Bratislava Castle overlooks old town and the Danube. During the city tour; Castle of Bratislava, St. Martin Cathedral, Grassalkovich Palace, Parliament, and National Theatre Building will be seen. Free time. Proceed to Budapest. Upon arrival, check in the hotel and resting. Dinner and overnight will be in the hotel.

DAY-8 - BUDAPEST (B,D) Breakfast at the hotel. Today, we will discover Budapest which is the capital city of Hungary. Panoramic city tour in Budapest. During the city tour; Erzsébet Bridge, Gellert Hill, Fisher Tower, St. Matthias Cathedral, the Parliament Building, Heroes Square, will be seen. The Halászbástya or Fisherman's Bastion is one of the best-known monuments in Budapest, located in the Buda Castle, in the 1st district of Budapest. It is one of the most important tourist attractions due to the unique panorama of Budapest from the Neo-Romanesque lookout terraces. St. Matthias Church, The Church of the Assumption of the Buda Castle, more commonly known as the Matthias Church, more rarely the Coronation Church of Buda, is a Roman Catholic Church located in the Holy Trinity Square, Budapest, Hungary, in front of the Fisherman's Bastion at the heart of Buda's Castle District. Free time. Experience Danube River Cruise with Dinner. Overnight will be in the hotel.

DAY-9 - BUDAPEST - BRNO - PRAGUE (B,D) Breakfast at the hotel and check out. Departure for Brno which is the second largest city in the Czech Republic and the largest city in the historical Moravia region. Founded around the year 1000, the city acted as one of historical capitals of the region, and today is home to many institutions related to Moravian history and culture. At the same time, Brno represents the administrative center of the contemporary South Moravian Region, and is the headquarters of the republic's judicial system. With a population around 380,000, Brno is located in a beautiful natural environment between South Moravian vineyards and the Moravian Karst, and is an easy drive to the nearby Austrian border. Upon arrival, starting a brief selective tour by visiting Ossuary at the Church of St. James or simply Bone Church which is often Paris, second largest ossuary in Europe. The number of people buried here is estimated to exceed 50,000. There was a churchyard at the Church of St. James (the site is) now Squares early as the beginning of the 13th century. Proceed to Prague. Upon arrival to Prague, Dinner and overnight will be in our hotel.

DAY-10 - PRAGUE - FRANKFURT (B,D) Breakfast in the hotel. Then panoramic city tour in Prague. Prague, capital city of the Czech Republic, is bisected by the Vltava River. Nicknamed, the City of a Hundred Spires, it's known for its Old Town Square, the heart of its historic core, with colorful baroque buildings, Gothic churches and the medieval Astronomical Clock, which gives an hourly show. City Tour, including Old Town Square, the Astronomical Clock and great view of Charles Bridge. Then go and join The Castle Tour to get deeper insight to the Prague's Castle, the world's largest medieval castle. We will experience Vltava River Cruise and enjoy Prague Old Town from river side. Free time. Lunch will be in local restaurant. After lunch, departure for Frankfurt. Upon arrival to Frankfurt, transfer to hotel for check in and resting. Dinner and overnight will be in the hotel.

DAY-11 - FRANKFURT - PARIS (B,D) Breakfast at the hotel and check out from the hotel. We will have city tour in that beautiful German city. Frankfurt, a central German city on the river Main, is a major financial hub that's home to the European Central Bank. It's the birthplace of famed writer Johann Wolfgang von Goethe, whose former home is now the Goethe House Museum. Like much of the city, it was damaged during World War II and later rebuilt. Free time. Proceed to Paris. Upon arrival, we will transfer to hotel for check in and resting. Dinner and overnight will be in the hotel.

DAY-12 - PARIS (B,D) Breakfast at the hotel. We will meet at the lobby. Driving to Trocadero we will see the best view of Eiffel Tower for feeling that we are in Paris! After visiting this famous icon, we will walk to the other side of the tower to Ecole Militaire. You can then take a leisurely cruise along the river Seine, a great sightseeing option that offers splendid views of iconic Parisian landmarks, including Notre-Dame Cathedral and Pont Alexandre III. After an exhilarating morning of walking the gallery corridors, replenish your energy levels with lunch in the museum before heading to the area surrounding the Palais Garnier, Paris's opera house. Free time. Dinner will be in local restaurant. Back to hotel and overnight will be in the hotel.

DAY-13 - PARIS END (B) Breakfast at the hotel and check out from the hotel. Free time.
